

FLIGHT SCHOOL GRANT Honoring Amelia Earhart

General Information

Amelia Earhart was a member of Zonta International at the time her plane was lost at sea. Zonta International established the Amelia Earhart Fellowship for women pursuing Ph.D./doctoral degrees in aerospace engineering and space sciences. The Zonta Club of Houston Educational & Charitable Fund has established Flight School Grants honoring Amelia Earhart for high school students and undergraduate students who are planning a career in aviation to assist them to attend flight school to earn their pilot's license. Applicants must be a resident of greater Houston or attend school in greater Houston. This is a one year pilot program. If the program is renewed for future years, applicants can reapply for future grants.

The Grant

The Flight School Grants honoring Amelia Earhart are awarded to women who reside in or attend school in the greater Houston area who have had at least one hour of flight training at an accredited flight school, who are planning to go on to a career in aviation, whether flight or technical. The grant of at least \$200 will be paid directly to the flight school.

Who is Eligible?

Women in the greater Houston area of any age, currently in high school, having graduated high school within a year, or currently in an undergraduate program who are planning a career in aviation. The undergraduate program can be a non-collegiate training program that is for an aviation career.

What are the Requirements?

Applicants must meet the following minimum requirements:

- 1. Currently attending high school or are a high school graduate.
- If a high school graduate, must have graduated within one year, or is currently attending an undergraduate program. The undergraduate program can be a non-collegiate training program that is for an aviation career

- 3. Applicants should have completed at least one hour of flight school. If an hour of flight school has not been completed, the applicant must describe their reasons for not being able to complete this requirement.
- 4. Description of initiative, ambition and commitment to pursuing a career in aviation, whether in flight or technical areas

How Do I Apply?

Complete an official application. Please note that only typed applications will be accepted and considered. The following documents are to be submitted in the application package. Applications can be downloaded from the Zonta Club of Houston website, (www.zontahouston.org) and must include:

- 1. One (1) recommendation from a faculty member in aviation. The faculty member can be with a flight school.
- 2. One (1) recommendation from an employer, volunteer supervisor, or academic advisor.
- 3. Essay of 300 words or less that clearly describes your academic and professional goals, the relevance of your program to the aviation field, demonstrates your initiative, ambition and commitment to pursuing a career in aviation, and defines how the Flight School Grant will assist you in reaching your goals.
- 4. Essay of 200 words or less that clearly describes your participation in community service and other outside activities.
- 5. Verification of current enrollment or graduation from high school.
- 6. Verification of completion of at least one hour of flight school or an essay describing why this requirement has not been fulfilled.
- 7. Applications are accepted by email or regular mail; however, email submissions are preferred. Applications submitted by email must be signed and sent as a PDF.
- 8. Applications must be received by July 1, 2022. Grants will be awarded by July 18, 2022.

What is the Consideration Process?

The club evaluation committee will consider applications and select the grant recipients. The number of grants and the amount of the grants will be determined by the funds available.
